Who are we?

Alzheimer's Society is the leading care and research charity for people who are affected by dementia.

Throughout England, Wales and Northern Ireland staff and volunteers provide essential local support to people with dementia and their families and friends and we reach out to even more people through our online and telephone based services.

Through our campaigning and policy work we ensure that the voices of people with dementia are heard by policy makers and opinion formers, and through our award winning research programme we are adding to the body of knowledge about dementia each year.

Local services in Warrington were established in September 2010 and are run by a small team of staff supported by dedicated volunteers.

Our Dementia Support Service is funded by Warrington Borough Council and the 5 Boroughs Partnership supported by our own fundraising efforts and donations.

How we can help

Whether you are a person living with dementia or you are caring for someone with dementia we understand and are able to support you through your dementia journey.

We offer free support, information and advice to all affected via a variety of services.

Outreach Services

Dementia Adviser Service

Our Dementia Adviser works primarily with people with dementia. Providing quality information and signposting at the point of diagnosis which is tailored to individual need. A detailed plan of information will be developed which aims to empower the person with dementia and promote independence. After the information plan has been developed at an initial meeting a follow-up meeting 2 to 4 weeks later will allow further questions to be asked and support will be given to allow the person to independently access a range of services.

The Dementia Adviser will work with carers and family members where the person with dementia lacks capacity. The service is based at Hollins Park but appointments can be made at home or other convenient place. The Dementia Adviser would refer onto our Dementia Support Worker for ongoing support where needed.

Dementia Support Service

Our Dementia Support Worker works with both carers and people with dementia throughout their journey. They provide emotional support, information and guidance to enable people to live as independently as possible.

The guidance may involve introduction to outside services as well as our own local support services.

Appointments can be made within a persons home or an other mutually convenient place.

Support Groups

Our support groups provide an opportunity for both the carer and the cared for to meet with others who are living with dementia. Support will be available from our Outreach workers as well as trained volunteers.

Dementia Café Group

The café group meets on the **second Monday of every month** from **2pm to 4pm** at The Holy Trinity Church, Market Gate, Warrington.

Refreshments are available.

Evening Support Group

The evening group meets on the **fourth Wednesday of the month** at: Brampton Lodge, Bridge Lane, Appleton, Warrington from **6.30pm to 8.30pm**.

Refreshments are available.

BHS Drop In Café

An informal drop in will take place on the first Wednesday of the month in the BHS café in Golden Square, Warrington.

The session will be held from **10am to 12pm**. Our trained volunteers will be available to chat with should you have any concerns regarding your memory or your caring role.
